Dear American International Academy Families,

We hope you and your family are staying safe and healthy during this time. Thank you for your patience as we work through these unique and unprecedented circumstances to continue to serve our students. On April 1, 2020, Governor Whitmer issued an Executive Order suspending face-to-face learning at K-12 schools for the remainder of the school year. Schools are now closed through the end of the academic year.

We will continue with free meal distribution during the shelter-in-place period because providing food is considered an “essential service.” The food distribution dates are Monday, April 6, 2020, and Wednesday, April 8, 2020, from 10 am - 1 pm at AIA-Henry Ruff, AIA-Avondale, AIA-Rosewood, Lemoyne Gardens, and Demby Terraces.

Wayne RESA has also published a list of all of the schools in the area that are offering meals to children. If your family needs additional food assistance, here, will find the link to these resources on the AIA webpage.

We are providing enrichment resources and activities for students to continue their learning and to reinforce the skills they have already learned. Homework packets have been mailed out to our K-8th grade classes and are also available for pick up during the times that meals are being given out. The 7th-12th grade students continue to have access to their assignment given in Google Classroom and on Khan Academy.
